Lesson Notes:

Having a Thankful Heart Part 1

When we think about our lives what a blessing it is to have a God that loves and cares for us. Following is a discussion of why we can be so thankful.

Scriptural Principles

- 1) A God that is Sovereign and Knows Our Needs In 2 Corinthians 9:8 Paul tells us that God will meet our needs. In Luke 11:9-13 Jesus tells us that our Father in Heaven loves us as a son or a daughter and is sufficient for our needs.
- 2) A God that loves us unconditionally In John 3:16 Jesus tells us that God loves us so much that he gave up his son so that we may have the opportunity for eternal life. In Ephesians 3:19 Paul tells us that the love of Jesus surpasses all knowledge. This means that we cannot comprehend the love that our Lord and Savior has for us.
- 3) A God that has restored his relationship with us through Jesus Christ In John 3:17 Jesus tells us that he came into the world so that the world may be saved. In Hebrews 9:12-14 we are told that Christ blood is sufficient as eternal redemption of our sins. In Hebrews 10:4, 10 we see that the sacrifice of bulls and goats are not sufficient to pay for our sins but Christ's sacrifice is the atonement for all of our sins.
- 4) That he forgives our sins- In Ephesians 2:8-9 Paul tells us that it is through God's grace that we are saved. In John 6:37 Jesus promises that he will turn no one away that comes to him. In John 1:12 the disciple John tells us that those that believe on his name will become sons and daughters of God.
- 5) That he is always with us In Matthew 28:19-20 he tells us that he will always be with us.
- 6) That he has given us the Holy Spirit In John 14:16-17 Jesus tells us that he will ask God the father to give us the Holy Spirit to dwell within our hearts.
- 7) That he hears our prayers In Luke 1:5-16 God heard the prayers of his faithful servants Zacharias and Elizabeth. In Matthew 7:11 Jesus tells us that God hears our prayers and knows what to give us.
- 8) That he has a plan for our Life In Romans 8:28 Paul tells us that all things work together for those that love God. In Galatians 1:15-16 Paul tells us that he was called to do God's work.
