## **Raising Godly Teens**

Teens are bombarded today with temptations from television, internet and at School. Today has to be the most challenging time in which to raise a Godly teen. Following are biblical principles for raising Godly teens.

## **Scriptural Principles**

- They need to understand that God has a Purpose for their Life. Romans
  8:28 Romans 8:28 tells us that all things work together for the good of those that love the Lord.
- 2) In the parable of the men given talents (Matthew 25:14-28) Christ teaches us the importance of planning ahead and investing your talents to reach your future rewards. Teens need to be taught at an early age that in order to get where you want to go you have to plan ahead and invest your talents wisely.
- 3) Proverbs 13:20 and 1 Corinthians 15:33 tells us that we must choose our friends wisely as a bad influence can lead to our destruction and destroy our character. Our teens must choose their friends and acquaintances wisely.
- 4) Paul tells us in Ephesians how a man should love his wife then in his letter to Titus he exhorts a woman to love her husband and honor him. A teen needs to see the love his father and mother have for each other so that he/she can build his/her home on a foundation of Love and Jesus Christ. Ephesians 5:25-33; Titus 2:4-5
- 5) Paul tells us in Colossians 3:21 not to be bitter to our children but encourage them in our ways.
- 6) David tells us in Psalm 34:11 to teach our children in the ways of the Lord. Isaiah 38:19 tells us to tell our children how faithful we are to the Lord. We need to encourage our children at an early age to be faithful to the Lord.
- 7) Proverbs and the Apostle Paul speaks directly to our teens encouraging them to seek the wisdom of their father and mother. Proverbs 1:8; Ephesians 6:1; Colossians 3:20
- 8) Don't be afraid to Reward your Son or Daughter for a Job well done. In the Story of the Prodigal Son the father rewards him when he returns. Luke 15:20-24
- 9) Finally prayer for your Teen. James 5:16
