What God Cannot Do

God is omniscient, omnipresent and all powerful, yet the Bible tells us that there are things that God cannot do. Following is a discussion of those things that God simply cannot do.

Scriptural Principles

- 1) **Recognize the Impossible** – Jesus tells us in **Matthew 19:26** that with God all things are possible.
- 2) **God can Never Leave or Forsake Us** – **Hebrews 13:5** tells us that God will never leave us or forsake us.
- 3) **God will never allow his people to be ashamed for their faith** – John tells us in **1 John 2:28** and **1 John 4:17** that we will not be ashamed when he returns. Paul tells us in **Romans 1:16** that he is not ashamed of the good news of Jesus Christ.
- 4) **God will never share his Glory with Another** – Isaiah tells us this in **Isaiah 42:8** & **Isaiah 48:11**.
- 5) **God will never break a promise** – God makes an “everlasting covenant with Abraham in **Genesis 13:15**, **Genesis 17:7-8** and **Genesis 17:13**. When God says “forever” he means “forever”.
- 6) **God does not change** – The Lord tells us this in **Malachi 3:6**. David also tells us this in **Psalms 102:27**.
- 7) **God will not remember our sin** – If we repent of our sins and accept the atoning grace of Christ’s sacrifice God tells us that he will remember our sin no more in **Jeremiah 31:34**.
- 8) **God can not justify sin without the remission of sin through the shedding of Blood by Jesus Christ.** – **Hebrews 9:22** tells us that there is no remission of sin without the shed blood of Jesus. Jesus tells us in **John 14:6** that no one comes to his father except through him.
